# APPROACH TO LEARNING OUTSIDE AUDITORS ON FLOODS IN ALBANIA' 2017

## What is BRIGAIID?

BRIGAIID is an acronym for "BRIdging the Gap for Innovations in Disaster Resilience", in Albanian "Kapërcimi i barrierave në fushën e novacionit në funksion të rekuperimit nga katastrofat"

The purpose of the BRIGAIID project is to gather innovative ideas on 3 main components of climate change, such as:

**FLOODS, DROUGHT** and **EXTREME WEATHER.**

Among these different ideas, the project will choose the most promising ones, which will be implemented and tested. The successful ideas will be supported in order to place them on the market to enable their implementation, acting as a catalyst or as a means for eliminating potential damages in cases of natural disasters.

## Purpose of the work:

This December began with man's confrontation with the forces of nature, causing the floods of 02 and 03 December 2017. The purpose of this on-site visit is to focus precisely on these floods.

The emergency situation and the number of areas affected by the river overflow are an indicator of the necessity to carry out on-site visits and to observe how people cope with these disasters, and how small they feel when faced with the immense forces of nature.

The BRIGAIID project, as a facilitator for overcoming natural disasters, aims to observe and include reality in its laboratory cycle as an input, in order to produce adequate navigations and vice versa.

## Required skills:

Candidates must have knowledge and education in Hydrology, Hydrotechnics, Environment, Geo-environment and other similar branches. They must have previous experiences on on-site monitoring and polls, as well as good communication and information management skills. The work will be carried out in groups, therefore the ability to actively discuss with colleagues is necessary.

Accommodation and travel costs will be covered by the organizers. Students will obtain daily reimbursements for the days spent outside of Tirana. The product of the course will be a bilingual publication.
