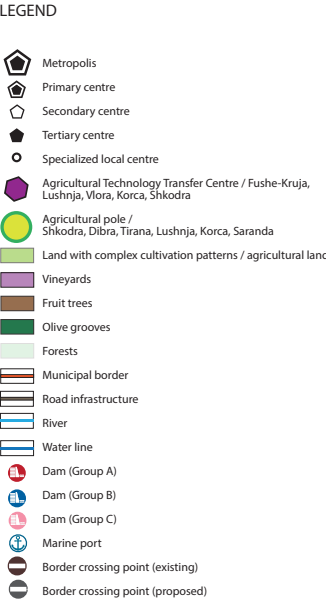
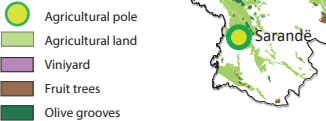
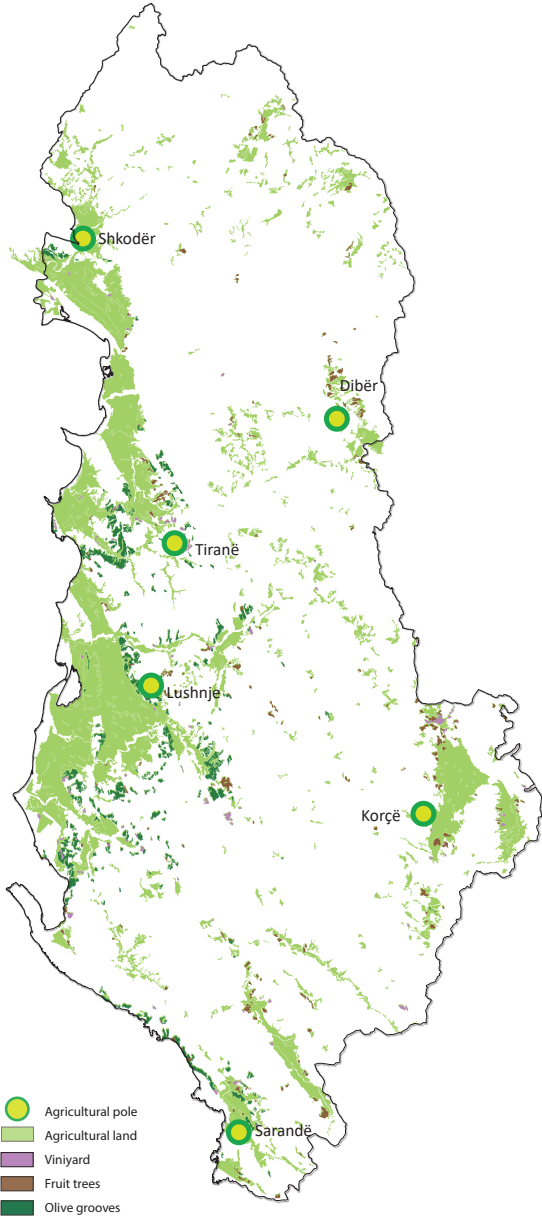
Principles

The agricultural system is based on 3 principles: Preservation, Consolidation and Modernization.

- Preserving the agricultural land fund means that no new construction will be allowed on agricultural land that is not consistent with the agricultural development.
- The agricultural land consolidation will be applied with the aim to increase the size of the agricultural farm and its efficiency.
- The modernization of the agricultural system will be achieved through the use of the new technology to increase the productivity of the agricultural farm.

Strategic projects include:

- Establishing and consolidating the 6 agricultural poles in Shkodra, Tirana, Dibra, Lushnja, Korça, Saranda. These poles represent a system per se which will consist in:
 - a) Establishing research centers to develop authentic agricultural crops;
 - b) Establishing adequate structures for the collection, processing and packaging of agricultural products of local farmers;
 - c) Setting up local markets for the promotion and marketing of bio-organic products.
- d) Protecting and promoting the remote mountainous areas, forests, fodders and other areas suitable for the cultivation of aromatic plants;
- d) Promoting the connections for research and development between the innovation centers and those of agricultural food processing.
